In light of the serious concerns relative to COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) and the current State of Emergency that exists in the Borough of Spotswood, please be advised of the following changes to sanitation services:

- All household trash **must be bagged.** If you use an outdoor trash receptacle, please put the bags in the receptacle(s) to be placed at the curb; however, no loose trash is allowed. Trash that is not bagged **will not** be picked up.
- Metal will be picked up as scheduled on March 26; however, no new pickups will be scheduled.
- Bulk will be picked up as scheduled on March 30; however, no new pick-ups will be scheduled.
- Residents can continue to drop off metal and electronics to the designated areas at the recycling center. No trash may be left at the center.

These changes become effective on Monday, March 23, and will remain in effect until further notice. We appreciate the cooperation of our residents as we strive to provide the best possible service while protecting our work force.
